Complex Case and Support Plan

Overview

Multidisciplinary approach to managing prisoners with complex mental health / addiction / related needs – to help develop specific, individualised care, support and development plans. The management of each individual case links Psychology, SMT, SMS, Health Care, Mental Health, NPS/OMU, 3<sup>rd</sup> sector stakeholders and Key Discipline Staff, to ensure appropriate interventions and support is provided; within an individualised (formal) plan. The approach focuses on IPPs, as well as vulnerable and challenging prisoners, to provide tailored support to help them engage with the regime, and progress through their sentence, whilst reducing their risk of harm to self and others.

HMIP have identified the approach as unique to Coldingley and an example of good practice worth rolling out more widely.
