# Opt Out

# Overview

'Opt Out' is a three week intensive Education Training Employability programme, developed in partnership with Humberside Police, and delivered by National Employer Training. The programme aims to help service users with practical issues such as opening a bank account, organising ID and understanding the benefits system, before moving on to vocational training, and the opportunity to gain up to 15 nationally accredited qualifications such as a forklift licence, as well a Safety Passport and CSCS card. Ongoing support is offered following completion of the three week course to apply for access work placements/further education - this is delivered by 'Navigators' with lived experience. This programme is open to both NPS and CRC service users. Lunch is provided to ensure that those who could not afford to buy lunch are not excluded.

### Benefits

The programme aims to improve social inclusion, and help service users successfully transition away from the criminal justice system. In the first 12 months, 38 people completed the programme (fewer than anticipate owing to Covid) – with 8 now in work, 2 continuing in education, and 8 still working with 'Navigators'.

This is currently unique to Grimsby probation.
