AXIS project

Overview

AXIS is an IT initiative which brings together data in a visual and user-friendly way, from a wide range of sources, relating to young people at risk of, or involved in Possession with the Intent to Supply Drugs (County Lines), Child Sexual Exploitation (CSE), Serious Youth Violence and children Missing from Home, School and Care. It helps identify more effectively the range of challenges and issues which may need to be addressed to help support and protect the young person concerned, enabling appropriate wrap around services to be engaged; as well as helping to uncover networks and associations that might place them and others at additional risk, and which might themselves be a target for intervention by the YOT and related agencies.

AXIS won the MJ (Municipal Journal) Local Government Achievement Awards in the Innovation in Children's Services Category in 2019, and is finalist in the Children and Young People Awards 2020.
