Cat D survival course

#### Overview

At Whatton we were receiving a number of prisoners who had returned to us after they had failed to cope in open prisons – at one point as many as 60 men were returnees from Cat D. We created a programme, put together by a psychologist, in consultation with those people who had returned from Cat D prisons, to help to improve the chances of "survival" for everyone moving to a more open regime. This project has been well received and prisoners report that feel more prepared and confident about the transition to open conditions.
